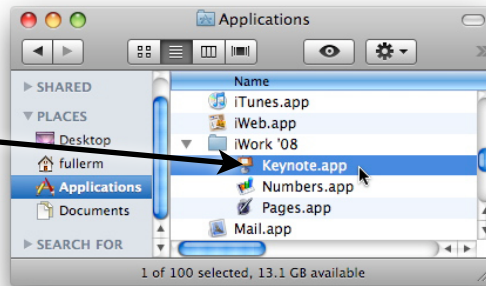


# Create a Photo Slideshow in Keynote with a Soundtrack

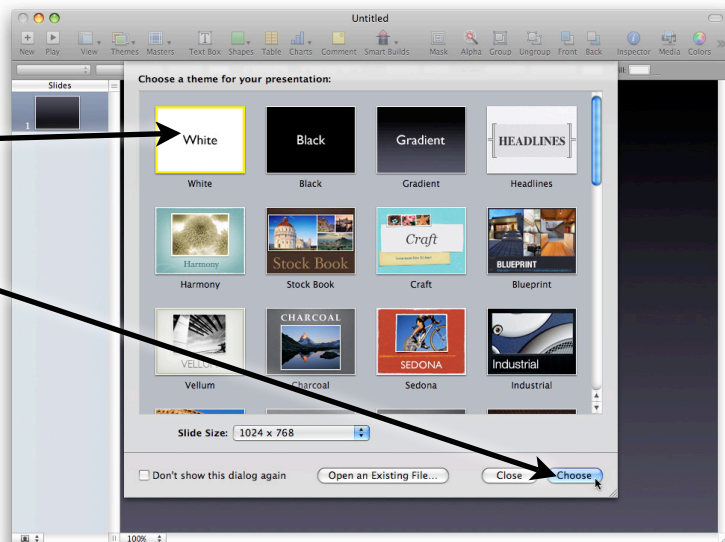
1. Launch the application Keynote from the Dock.

or

Open the **Applications** folder, open the **iWork '08** folder, and double-click the **Keynote** application.



2. Click to select a **Theme** for your presentation and click **Choose**.



## Option 1: Import Photos Using the Media Browser

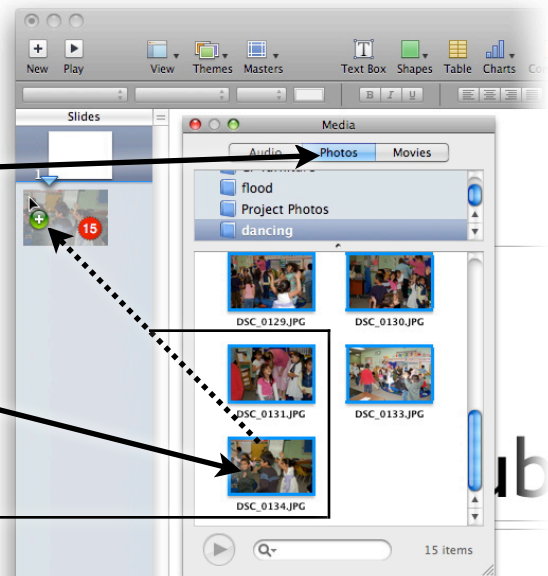
1. Click the **Media Browser** to open it.



Click the **Photos** tab to see the photos in iPhoto.

2. Select several photos (press and hold the *option* key on the keyboard and click each photo once to select).

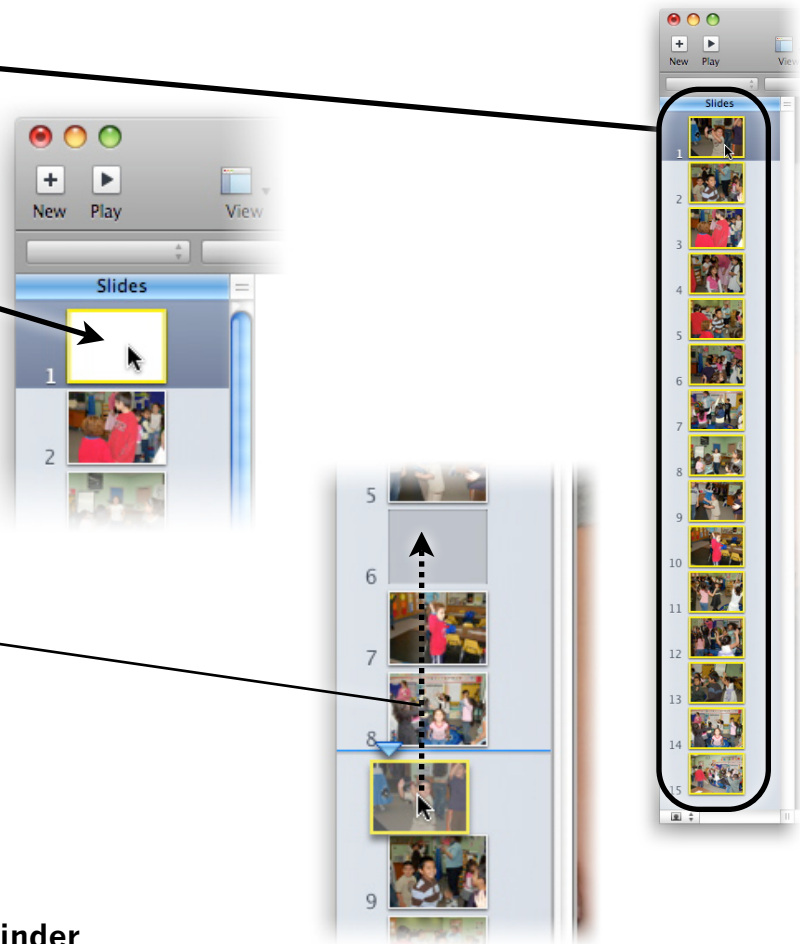
3. Drag the photos from the **Media Browser** into the slide sorter.



4. Notice that each photo is imported onto a separate slide.

5. Delete blank slides if necessary (click the slide to select a slide in the slide sorter and press the *delete* key on the keyboard).

6. Reorder slides if necessary (click and drag a slide to a new position in the slide sorter).



## Option 2: Import Photos from the Finder

1. Locate photos on your computer.

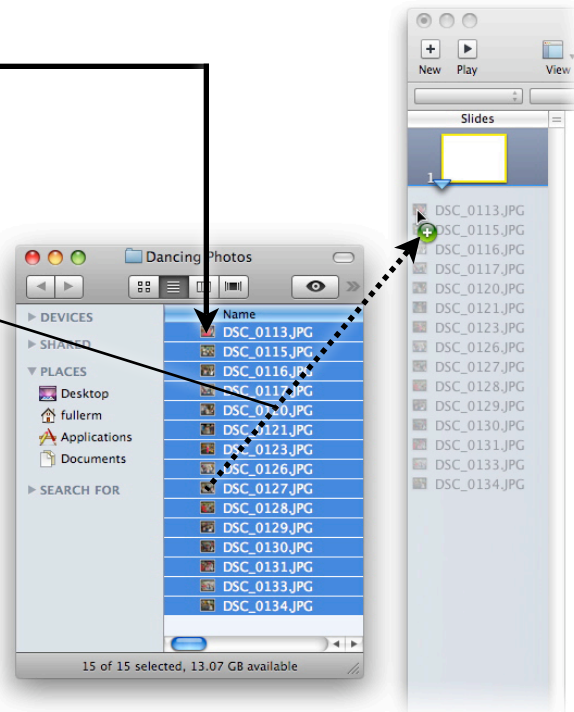
Select several photos (press and hold the *option* key on the keyboard and click each photo once to select or **Edit | Select All** in a folder).

2. Drag the photo icons from the computer into the slide sorter of Keynote.

3. Notice that each photo is imported onto a separate slide.

4. Delete blank slides if necessary (click the slide to select a slide in the slide sorter and press the *delete* key on the keyboard).  
*See step 5 above for visual.*

5. Reorder slides if necessary (click and drag a slide to a new position in the slide sorter).  
*See step 6 above for visual.*



## Add Transitions and Music

1. Select all slides in the slide sorter (click a slide to select it and then select **Edit | Select All**).

2. Open the **Inspector** and select the **Slide Inspector**.

Click the **Transition** tab.

3. Select an **Effect** from the pop-up menu and a **Duration** time for the **Effect**.

Set the transition to begin **Automatically** and set a **Delay** (the amount of time a slide will show on the screen).

4. Open the **Document Inspector** and click the **Audio** tab.

5. Click the **iTunes Library** button. Notice that the **Media Browser** opens with the **Audio** tab selected.

6. Drag a music file into the **Soundtrack** well in the **Document Inspector**.

7. Select **Play Once** or **Loop** for the audio selection.

8. Click **Play** to play the slideshow.
